All of these elements have caused us, as an Exco, to feel it is necessary to increase the subscriptions for 2016. Besides that, there has been minor progress on the MG's sleeping the garage and all going well it will be 3/4 by the end of the year! I suspect that 4/4 will be some time off given the amount of work waiting ahead of me on the J2, but that's okay - 75% is just fine with me...

From the Treasurer

You will know from previous Newsletters about the crime issues we have experienced this year. To protect our assets while the Clubhouse is empty, and ourselves at meetings, we decided that we had to install an alarm system, and subscribe to an armed response provider. In addition to the entry alarms and beams, we have strategically placed panic buttons for emergency use.

This obviously comes at a cost, and we obtained quotes from service providers, and ended up with Fidelity Security.

The alarm system installation cost around R16 000, and the armed response costs R450 per month. A lot of money for a small club like ours, but in today's crime ridden world we felt it essential. In addition to this we have had some maintenance issues with the Clubhouse, especially the electrical DB board, the ceiling and the fridge.

Repairs and replacement stock after the break-ins has also been costly.

Fortunately, the club has had a few good years, and we had the capital available to cover all these extra expenses.

However, we must also realise that the monthly costs to operate the Clubhouse have also been increasing. The cost of electricity, water, rates , the lease and gardener/cleaner etc are all rising continuously.

The unfortunate consequence of all the above is that we need more income, and whilst we can try to run fund raising events, we need to ensure our viability with an increase in membership fees.

In terms of the Club constitution, the Exco is empowered to increase the fees once per year. The last increase was from January 1st 2015. The Exco has therefore decided to set the membership fees, from Jan 1st 2016, at <u>R330</u> per year, for a full member and <u>R180</u> per year for country members and others. Joining fees will rise to <u>R180</u>.

A discount of R30 on each of these amounts may be applied if payment is made by EFT.

As stated above, these fees apply from January 1st 2016. Any membership renewals prior to year end, will be at the current rates of **R250** and **R125**. respectively. (**Plus R25 if paid by cash or cheque**).

I realise that this is an increase for the second year running, but we did not foresee the crime and other issues that occurred.

Please pay promptly to support your club, and save yourself the increase for another year.

Come to the events, and Noggins, as the income generated also helps keep the club going.
